## **1.0 PRODUCT DESCRIPTION**

#### 4.0 CONTRAINDICATIONS

1. Adhesive Remover should not be used on skin where infection is present.

2. Do not use this product if there is a known allergic sensitivity to any of the ingredients.

3. Do not use on open wounds, damaged or broken skin.

#### 5.0 WARNINGS

Adhesive Remover in liquid form is flammable; use in a well ventilated area. Avoid using around flames and sources of ignition. Keep out of reach of children. Do not use if pack is damaged or open. Avoid contact with eyes. For external use only. Do not swallow.

Do not re-use wipe. Re-use of single-use devices creates a potential risk of infection to the patient or user. It may also lead to degraded performance or a loss of functionality. Contamination and/or limited functionality of the device may lead to injury, illness or death of the patient.

#### 6.0 DIRECTIONS FOR USE

When removing adhesive dressings:

- 1. Visually inspect the packaging for damage prior to use.
- 2. Lift up edge of plaster and apply Adhesive Remover under the dressing while lifting off.
- 3. Peel away the plaster slowly while continuing to apply more Adhesive Remover as the dressing begins to lift.
- 4. After wiping clean the surrounding skin area, a new adhesive dressing can be applied if required.
